Fresh oysters

For seafood lovers, perhaps nothing is more mouthwatering than freshly shucked oysters served on a bed of crushed ice and seaweed.

Method

- 1. When you buy oysters, make sure that they are tightly closed and heavy in the hand
- 2. Give them a rinse in cold water before you start preparing them
- 3. To open them, you'll need an oyster knife which is short, thick and quite blunt.
- 4. Hold the oyster curved-side down on a chopping board with a folded kitchen cloth between the shell and your hand. Look for the hinge between the top shell and the bot tom shell, and poke the knife tip into the crack. You need to push hard.
- 5. When you get the oyster open, throw away the top shell. If there is any seawater in the bottom shell with the oyster, try and keep it in there.

 6. Pick out any fragments of shell and place the oyster on a plate with a mound of
- rock salt or crushed ice in the middle.
- 7. Season it with lemon juice or pickled red onions juice



Focaccia

Ingredients

- •500g strong white bread flour
- 2 tsp salt
- •2 sachets dried easy
- blend yeast •2 tbsp olive oil
- •400ml cold water olive oil, for
- drizzling •fine sea salt

In a large bowl, stir together the flour, salt, sugar, yeast, garlic powder, oregano, thyme, basil and black pepper. Mix in the vegetable oil and water.

When the dough has pulled together, turn it out onto a lightly floured surface, and knead until smooth and elastic. Lightly oil a large bowl, place the dough in the bowl, and turn to coat with oil. Cover with a damp cloth, and let rise in a warm place for 20 minutes.

Preheat oven to 450 degrees F (230 degrees C). Punch dough down; place on greased baking sheet. Pat into a 1/2 inch thick rectangle. Brush top with olive oil. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and mozzarella cheese.

Bake in preheated oven for 15 minutes, or until golden brown. Serve warm







THE MOULDING AREA

The moulding area is now in total 8,000 square meters, when the new moulding area under construction is completed, Marex UAB will be prepared for future growth. The production facility includes a total of fifty acres of land, providing unlimited possibilities for extensions and high flexibility.

As part of the development, we started work in 2017 on the construction of a completely new moulding building of 3,500 square meters. Using modern production technology, we laminate all hulls, deck and other parts in-house. All major components like hull and deck are vacuum-moulded, while smaller parts that require high levels of manual work are produced by hand.

Why vacuum moulding?


The principle of vacuum moulding is that the raw materials can be pre-cut and laid out after a certain level of dryness in the mould. Then the entire mould is covered with a plastic film.

Through small hoses placed in strategic places, a vacuum is created. At the same time, polyester is released and sucked in to the mould. This process enhance the laminating process and allow us to have full control of how much strength and weight we add to the various parts of the boat.

Vacuum moulding achieves a more ideal relationship between glass and polyester in the finished laminate. It is the glass that gives strength, while the polyester is a pure bonding-agent to hold the glass in place. Therefore, it is an advantage if you can reduce the amount of polyester as this will reduce the total weight of the laminate. Vacuum moulding reduces the risk of air bubbles remaining in the laminate.

The quality of the finished product is also much less dependent on human factors that otherwise could affect the quality outcome. Vacuum moulding is a completely closed process. This means drastically reducing the emissions of harmful gases in connection with the construction process. This is of great importance to the people who build the boats and the surrounding environment.





CUTTING AREA

There are hundreds of moulded components in a modern leisure boat. Before the assembly of the boat can begin, hulls, deck and other components are sent to the department that makes the final finish of corners and edges by hand.

Here, excess glass fibre is cut away and smaller components adjusted before edges and corners exposed receive a final coat covering of topcoat gel for optimal finish and durability.

In addition, openings are cut into feeds, hatches and windows. In this section we also have a separate spray bay where we apply Nextell coating on the dashboard and other modules in the cockpit that require antireflection surfaces.

FINAL ASSEMBLY

At Marex, the boats are manufactured according to the line principle, with specialized teams taking care of all installations at different stages of production.

All main installations such as engine, hot water, warmer, power, thrusters, tanks and other interior fittings are mounted in the hull before lifting the deck and cabin mouldings together and joining to the hull.

Then installation of all other components and accessories, covers, pillows and fittings. At each station on the production line there are dedicated bays that contain all components to be mounted on board at each stage of the process. This is a demanding logistics task that ensures a streamlined production without costly interruptions.

QUALITY CHECK, TESTING AND DELIVERY Marex delivers motorboats in the premium seqment, and therefore attaches great importance

to quality control throughout the manufacturing process.


The last part of this quality control is a comprehensive test procedure that each boat reviews before being forwarded to the dealer. In addition, Marex simulates rain and water over the entire boat in a separate test pool to ensure that the boats are free from leaks.

Marex has developed systems that enable us to ensure our customer's satisfaction. The on-water testing enables us to check all of the onboard comhundred point audit; the electronic system, engine, aims and feedback from all our customers.

heating system, lighting, and navigation and so on. This process eliminates any production anomalies. The testing team is responsible for reporting all faults to the team leader in the production line. Through this procedure the causes of anomalies are analysed and eliminated refining the whole production process. By doing this prior to delivery of the boat, delivery is expedited and waiting time is reduced.

Before we deliver the boat from the factory it is thoroughly cleaned, washed and packaged; and on arrival of a Marex boat to a dealer a visual internal and external inspection is conducted.

Marex Dealer in the heart of Europe

A total of 436 metres above sea level, on Lake Lucerne in Switzerland, is one of Europe's foremost dealers of Scandinavian boats - namely Hochmuth Bootsbau AG in Stansstad.

The company was established in 1960 by Hermann Hochmuth, who quickly specialized in boats manufactured in Scandinavia throughout the 1960s. They have maintained this position as a leading boat supplier since then, with well-known brand names like Marex, Windy, Draco and Saga in the portfolio.

Previously, they also represented manufacturers such as Nidely, Polar and Nor Star. Centrally located in the heart of Europe, Hochmuth Bootsbau AG. Today, Hochmuth Bootsbau AG is owned and managed by Hugo Scherer, who bought the company in 1998. They have represented Marex in Switzerland since 2010.

Why did you choose to bet on Marex?

-There is a two-part answer to that question. Partly because the former dealer was in trouble and therefore we contacted Marex to offer to take over the dealership.

We quickly agreed with the Aalruds and have been the Marex dealer in Switzerland since. Secondly, we wanted to have well-built boats with strong Norwegian roots in our portfolio, which was challenging given that both Nor Star and Nidelv had discontinued their operations in Norway. Norwegian boats are built for rough conditions, and Norwegian boats have good canopy and cover solutions.

We do not have much wind and high sea here compared to Norway, but we have a lot of rain. And then it is important for well-functioning and simple canopies, campers and covers. Marex majors brilliantly in this area.

What is your background in the boat industry?

-I grew up with my father's boat. He was also a Hochmuth customer since the start of the 1960s. After my education in Zurich, I traveled around Europe as a



service mechanic / engineer for a Swiss company, before I started Swissarmy in the bridge building department of what is called the Swiss Navy due to their boats for floating Bridges, following this I got a job in a forklift & Logistic companie "STILL" to build wearhouses. By chance, I was given the opportunity to buy Hochmuth Bootsbau AG in 1998.

The company was then down and was characterized by internal disputes. Together with two key people who had worked in the company for a long time, Othmar Zingg & Hans-Ueli Keller we created a holding company and bought

Hochmuth before we started the job of building the company to what it is today. My two partners have now retired while I continue as sole proprietor.

What is important for Swiss customers when buying a boat in this class?

-Let me say this: You can buy a 32-foot boat for 100,000 Euro. It will work, but it's not a Marex. If you are interested in investing a little more, you get timeless quality, low maintenance and so on. There you will find the typical Marex customer.

The boats are usually used on the Swiss Lakes, and they are usually moored in a marina which is the starting point for day trips, for example, to a restaurant, and to some extent also overnight trips. If you want to move the boat from one locale to another, we also organize it for our customers, says Scherer.


If you chose a Marex yourself, which one?

-It must be Marex 310 or 375. Neither I nor my partner have children, and for us two, Marex 310 works well when we go out to sunbathe and swim. But sometimes we travel on weekend trips, and then the 375 is the ultimate option because it offers the extra space we want.

Often, we travel after working hours in the summer to a restaurant, moored up there and eat before we return home in the evening. We also have customers from, for example, Zurich who spend their holiday on Lake Lucerne, and typically choose a 375, something I had done, concludes Hugo Scherer.

"IT IS IMPORTANT FOR WELL-FUNCTIONING AND SIMPLE CANOPIES"

"Design is a result of the user's behavior and needs. Not the other way around"



Espen Aalrud, second generation owner of Marex has a clear design philosophy. It deviates from the mainstream thinking, but after receiving all of Europe's most prestigious design awards, there is little doubt that the basic idea behind the Marex concept meets a major need in the market.

"We started the development of the new generation Marex models in 2008. We were fully aware that we wanted a distinctive classic expression," says Espen Aalrud, who is leading the product development in Marex. -In the meantime, the functional design should be cutting edge and state of the art and show direction into the future.

The basic idea behind the new generation Marex is that the boats should be adapted to the users' behavior and wishes. Traditionally in the boat industry there have been the boats that have defined the behavior of the users and not the other way round. This was not a way we wanted to go, our boats should be the easiest to use, explains Espen Aalrud.

A clear thought.

After Espen Aalrud had his debut as a boat designer with Marex 21 Duckie that time together with Espen Thorup and until today's Marex 375, the former Fevik-based manufacturer has undergone a tremendous development. A boating family has grown up with its own distinctive language, and Marex has more than any other manufacturer put in considerable resources in the effort to create smart, functional solutions.

The goal has been to minimize the number of sources of irritation and increase both comfort and ease of use. The boat pleasure is bigger if everything is done easier. They are successful. Innovative, intelligent solutions are paired with aesthetics and ease of use in a way that Marex is alone.

Espen Aalrud, initially a lawyer by profession, decided early to direct development work as Marex would change into a new design language. Aalrud's basic

insight into how customers use their boats has been crucial in the development of format solutions, deck layout, space utilization and class-leading cabin design.

He wanted to throw old thoughts out of the window and find solutions that optimize time to enjoy boating and minimize the number of issues and concerns. This is a strong driving force behind the work of Espen Aalrud. We really learn the most from listening to our customers. We receive constructive and good input from boat owners at fairs. It is inspiring. The package must have a design that also keep the value of the boat over time.

Demanding processes

-A boat is always a compromise. The relationship between costs and wishes must always be included in the assessment. It is very important to define the target group for each model. Age group, family situation, user behavior and the environment in which the boat is to be used are factors that are very important for what qualities and solutions we must prioritize, says Aalrud.

Espen Aalrud is based in Norway, but works closely with a team of engineers and programmers in Europe and at Marex's yard in Kaunas, Lithuania. Many of the employees are involved in the process. From the first ideas, the sketch is made, in close dialogue with Saulius Pajarskas general manager at Marex in Lithuania, through the most experienced craftsmen, as well as the most proficient carpenters.

Then an intense 3D design process takes place. The great 3D designer Kristijan Nikl in Slovenia sews everything together. The result of a good teamwork. From there it goes to milling of plug to finished shape. Only then can the boats be put into production. Such a process can easily take 6000 to 7000 hours before the first boat is made. The team is constantly working to find the best production technology solutions to keep costs down.



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
